The Kleinheubacher Tagung 2026 of the U.R.S.I. Landesausschuss in Deutschland e.V. is the annual meeting of the U.R.S.I. Member Committee in Germany and will take place in the Old Townhall (Altes Rathaus) in Miltlenberg, Germany, from 22 to 26 September 2026. Conference languages are English and German, English contributions and presentations are preferred.

Regular Contributions (Talk):

Authors are asked to submit regular contributions by **28 June 2026** via <https://kh2026.edas.info/> stating title, author(s), abstract (in German or preferred English; text only; no more than 500 words; no figures, no equations, etc.) and selecting the Commission hosting the contribution. Acceptance notification will be sent by **27 July 2026**.

Prospectively, this year, again, in addition to the regular contribution (abstract) authors may submit a conference paper (up to 4 pages including bibliography, IEEE conference proceedings style) via <https://kh2026.edas.info/> latest by **4 October 2026**. After the usual peer review, this paper will be submitted to the IEEE Xplore Digital Library shortly after the conference, provided that the conference presentation actually took place.

Young Scientist Awards:

Scientists born in 1991 or later are invited to participate in the Young Scientist Award Program of the Kleinheubacher Tagung 2026. Applications and supporting materials have to be submitted by **10 June 2026** via <https://kh2026.edas.info/> in the indicated field on the website. Details can be found on page two of this call for papers.

Young Scientist Awards / Karl-Jörg Langenberg Awards on the Occasion of the Kleinheubacher Tagung 2026

As part of our continuing commitment to encouraging the next generation of early-stage researchers, we will offer up to 10 *Young Scientist Awards* (YSA). Three of these YSA recipients will be further selected for [Karl-Jörg Langenberg Awards](#) during the course of the conference.

The selection of YSA recipients will be based upon an examination of the documents submitted. Besides originality and creativity, form and clarity of the presented work will be assessed. The YSA includes a certificate, a waiver for the conference fees (the waiver is only for the young scientist, not for the co-authors), and a

Prize money of 250 €.

All YSA recipients are required to give a talk within the special YSA Session. During this YSA Session, the contributions will be evaluated by the Award Committee. The top three contributions will be awarded a Karl-Jörg Langenberg Award (KLA). In addition to a certificate and the stated prize money, the KLA recipients will receive:

5 000 €	(1 st Prize),
4 000 €	(2 nd Prize), and
3 000 €	(3 rd Prize)

(amounts subject to adjustments should there be multiple winners with the same score). All YSA and KLA recipients will be honored during the Kleinheubacher Tagung 2026.

Terms of Eligibility

Scientists born 1991 or later holding a Diploma or Master degree (received before 1st May 2026) at the minimum are invited to apply. The following documents, written in English only, are to be submitted via <https://kh2026.edas.info/> under the track “Young Scientist Awards” no later than **10 June 2026**:

- Extended Abstract (up to 4 pages including bibliography; IEEE Manuscript Template downloadable from: <https://www.ieee.org/conferences/publishing/templates.html>)
- Curriculum vitae in tabular form
- One letter of endorsement (1 page maximum) from a member of the U.R.S.I. Landesausschuss in Deutschland e.V. (German U.R.S.I. committee)
- Duly completed and signed YSA application form https://www.kh2026.de/ysa_application_form.pdf
- Copy of the Diploma or Master certificate

All applicants will be notified by **20 August 2026**.
